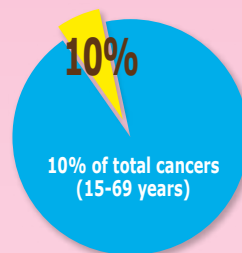

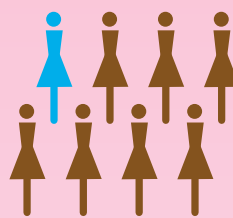

Breast Cancer in young women is the leading cause of AYA cancer deaths!

BREAST CANCER IS THE MOST COMMON CANCER IN YOUNG WOMEN (15-39 years)

- most cancer in young women appears to be random
- no routine breast screening available
- breast cancer in young women is often aggressive
- breast cancer does not always start as a breast lump
- most breast lumps are not breast cancer



EARLY DETECTION SAVES LIVES!

- young women need to self detect
- earlier diagnosis can occur when young women report unusual breast changes to her health care provider
- when diagnosed early there is usually a better chance of successful treatment
